## **SUBMIT YOUR DRAFT EIS COMMENTS BY AUGUST 13, 2021**

Comments that address a specific aspect of the project or the Draft EIS, rather than simply expressing a preference for or against a project alternative, are most useful. Comments should be as specific as possible. It is also helpful if the comments refer to chapters and pages of the Draft EIS.

- Specific topics to consider in your comments on the Draft EIS include:
- Comments on the information and analysis provided
- Comments on key components of the alternatives
- Comments on potential measures to avoid, minimize, or mitigate impacts
- Any new or additional information that should be included in the analysis and would support consideration of alternatives
- Any other considerations that should be included in the decision-making process
